



STUDENT INTERVENTION SPECIALIST JOB DESCRIPTION

THE POSITION: The program will serve the needs of students in Kindergarten through Fifth grade who are struggling in reading fluency, decoding, and comprehension. Students are placed in a small group using either a push-in or pull-out model. Admission to the RTI (Response to Intervention) program requires signed parent permission. Assessments will be administered each reporting period to determine accurate placement.

RESPONSIBLE TO: Superintendent/Principal

STATUS: Hourly; Non Exempt

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- Use the assessment data to plan and develop lessons.
- Provide small-group instruction utilizing remedial methods and curriculum for students that are at-risk.
- Cooperates in school-wide supervision of students during out of classroom activities.
- Works as part of a team to provide academic intervention for identified students.
- Works in conjunction with the classroom teacher to coordinate pull-out schedule for RTI students
- Reports student progress within the intervention program to teachers.
- Tracks data on student progress within the program.
- Attends RTI training as scheduled.
- Other duties as assigned by the Principal.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School diploma; Bachelor's Degree Preferred
- Ability to work independently, with little supervision.
- Ability and patience to motivate struggling learners.
- Appearance, grooming and personality which establish a desirable example for students.
- Maintain reliable attendance
